3. Review of Related Literature



10.1% students come Once in Month and 7.5% students come to library Occasionally





Table- 2: Time spent in the library.










According to the table- 5 most of the users are satisfied with the library services but according to some users some

6. Limitation

Currently, 3000 students and 150 teachers are users of the library. To make this study more accurate and specific, this survey covers all categories of users. 268 users responded out of which all users were covered by Google form in this survey, 79.5% are UG students, 5.2% PG students, 11.9% teaching staff, 3.4% non-teaching staff.

7. Finding and Suggestions:

The present study has brought out the following findings:

- The 22.4% of the users visit the library daily, 34.3% users visit the library two to three times in a week, 25.7% visits once in 15 days and 10.1% visit it once in a month. Only 7.5% users visit the library occasionally.
- 2. Most of student come library to books borrow, use e resources, Newspaper and reading purpose, faculty members visit library for academic purpose.

29.9 % users come to library for Borrows of books, 19% users come to library for Reference, 14.2 % users come to library for research work, and 9.3 users come to library for reading, 3% users come for NEWS paper and 2.2 users come to library for journals and 22.4% users come to library for other work.

- Most of the users are satisfied with all the facilities of the library but 47.76% users are not satisfied with the facility for drinking water and 30.59% users not satisfied for Digital Resources.
- 4. Overall satisfaction with the library is shown that, maximum percentage of users has rated the library as good and Excellent. Some user suggestions need to improvement.

The following important suggestion can be focuses:

- 1. Library should arrange more multiple copies of documents in all fields. Books of latest edition should be acquired. Library should also acquire more reference sources to satisfy the needs of the users.
- The library should organize more multiple copies of documents in all fields. Books of latest edition should be obtained. The library should also acquire more reference sources to satisfy the needs of the users.
- There should be good facility of drinking water
- User demand More computers with high-speed internet
- 5. should be more novel and general books collection

8. Conclusion

University libraries invest scores of rupees every year on the collection development in order to meet the need of users. In order to maximize the use of library resources, every library should build up its collection keeping in mind the need of users; and library should be designed with changing information environment. This study revealed

that nearly half of the total respondents visit library regularly and borrowing books is the main purpose of visiting library, followed by reading print journals and having access to online periodicals, reference sources and to read newspaper/magazine. This study revealed that printed books are still occupying a predominate place in library to meet students' information needs. P P Savani University Library subscribes 800+ titles per year and journals (print, 78+; online, 2403) and database through Delnet, J-Gate, ProQuest and Gale Medical Database. The study revealed that students and research scholars are highly satisfied with the collection of online journals and use these online journals both for academic and research purpose. ICT application in library services is also providing opportunities to users to access and utilize both library online resources and services effectively. Respondents are very much satisfied with the performance circulation.
